We are looking for someone who loves to be a pioneer and knows how to drive things. You will be the first person in this role at PWN Dublin. As a voluntary organisation, we need to be cost efficient, so we are looking for someone who knows how to maximize UX and leverage systems as cost efficiently as possible. Your tasks will consist of but not be limited to the following:

- First and foremost a member of the management committee of PWN Dublin
- Prepare for and attend monthly management committee call (currently done remotely but usually every second meeting is in person)
- Attend networking events and webinars
- Own all things tech and digital within the network (email, platform/website, file storage, PM tools etc.)
- Collaborate closely with Global VP of IT and PWN Dublin VP Membership for alignment and collaboration on existing and new member platform & website
 - Project currently underway to re-develop PWN Global and city network website (front and back end).
 - Assist in final scoping with preferred vendor
 - Attend workshops on functional areas of website
 - Beta testing
 - Embracing final product and championing it within the network
 - Supporting other committee members on enduring platform use
 - Ensuring content is up to date
- Implement new fileshare System (currently we use Dropbox need to investigate MS Teams etc. as an alternative)
- Implement smart ways in line with GDPR for Data Storage
- Implementing Project Management Tools where required
- Assist Marketing in Data Analytics and the right tools
- Consideration and streamlining of tools
 - Mentoring
 - o Trello
 - Webinars
 - Virtual Meetings
 - o Podcasts

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- Live Streaming of in-person events when they resume
- Build tech and digital working group of volunteers if desired

In terms of work load it is probably 4-5 hours a week. But if you are on a mission and love what you do it might be a little more. A term is 2 years for a full board position. It is on voluntary basis, but reasonable expenses are reimbursed where incurred and vouched.

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
